## AV & Room Setup Needs

### Microphones

Please provide a wireless lavalier (lapel) microphone. Please have a separate microphone for the person introducing Dale.

### Video Requirements

LCD projector which can be hooked into a laptop computer and a projection screen large enough for all in the audience to see clearly. If you do not have a rear projection, please place the screen and projector to the side of the stage so they do not block the view of the audience.

### Stage

A platform in the center front of the room, close to the audience, is preferred. Dale does not use a podium, but does need a small draped table for his various presentation materials.

### Audience Seating

Classroom or theater style with angled, or chevron-style, rows is first choice. A- U- or V-shaped seating is second choice. Individual round tables are least desired. If Dale is speaking after a meal, please allow time to ensure servers are not clearing dishes or serving desert or coffee during the presentation.

### Lighting

A well-lighted stage is best. If there are spotlights, please focus them for a general wash of light at the front of the stage. Please ensure lights are not directed onto the video screen.

### Recording

Recording of Dale's presentation is permitted, but requires Dale's written permission.
